

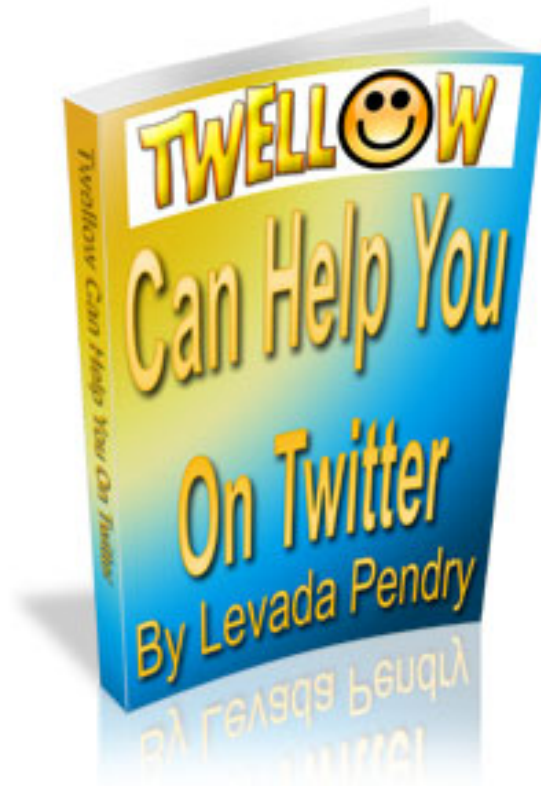

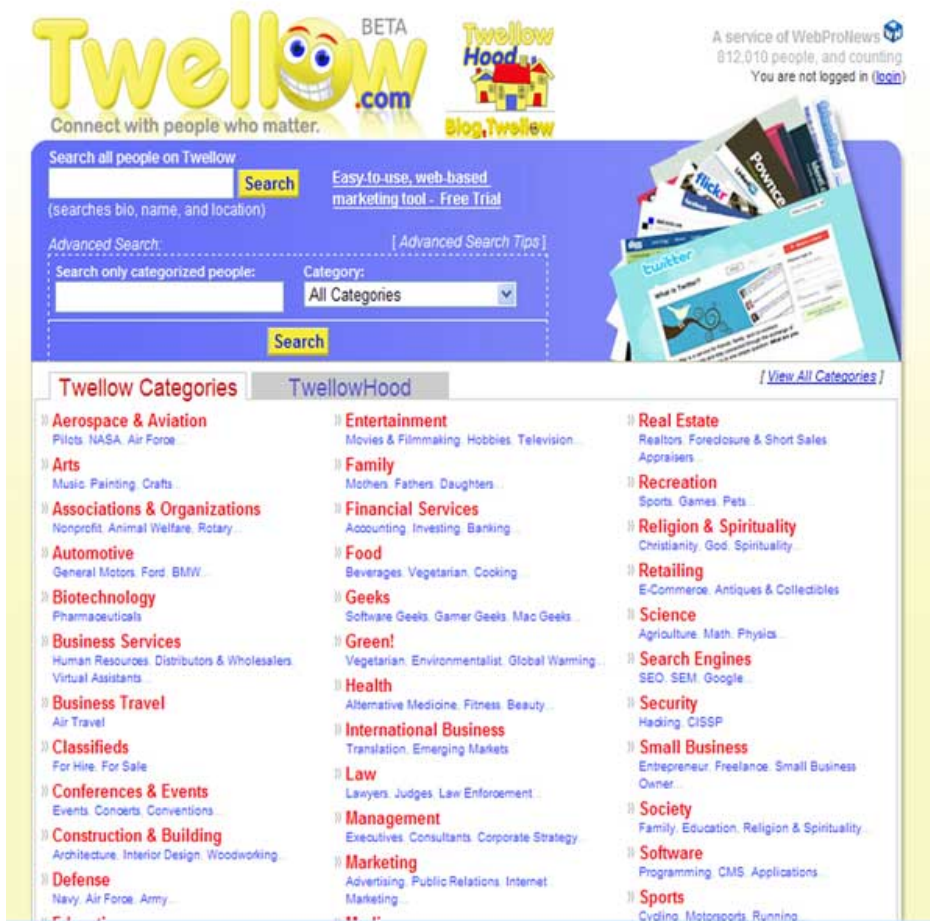


What Is Twitter and What Is Twellow

The Twitter website says: "Twitter is a service for friends, family, and co-workers to communicate and stay connected through the exchange of quick, frequent answers to one simple question: **What are you doing?**"

It is a lot of fun, and very quick and easy to do. You get 140 characters to answer the question. Unlike blogging which can be a long entry, Twitter is short and snappy. To type in a "Tweet" is only a few sentences. It doesn't matter if you want to share what you had for breakfast, or the latest marketing success! In other words, you can share what you want to share, and people can follow you and you can follow their posts.

You need to make yourself an account. Here is the Twitter website URL: www.Twitter.com



When you make your account, keep in mind that you can specify what categories you want to be in.

One of the harder things about Twitter is that it is difficult to search out other people. Twellow is a search engine for Twitter. It organizes Twitter people by categories and geographical locations.

This makes it much easier to find people!

Twellow Categories

The first thing you notice about the categories is that the main ones are in red and the sub categories are in blue. This greatly increases your ease of choice. If you look on the upper right hand of the screen you can click on "View All Categories". This will take you to a page with all the categories listed in red on the left and the sub categories listed in blue on the right.

One way to use this is to search for other people with your same interests. For example, under Publishing category, I picked Authors & Writers. This brings up a page with listings of authors. Under the yellow title bar you can get your own sort results. The default is "Followers Count". This will sort by how many followers each author has. Your other choices are "Last Activity" and "Twello Verified". I decided I wanted to contact only authors who are actively posting tweets, so I resorted under last activity and clicked on "update". This resorts the list.

You see the person's picture (if they have posted one), and under that is the grey "follow" button. Use this if you want to follow the person's postings. You really get a lot of information! You read their profile and where they are located. You can click on their website url to go check out their site. You can see how many followers they have, and few other bits of information.

Now I can scroll thru this list and look for authors interesting to me that I might want to follow or contact.

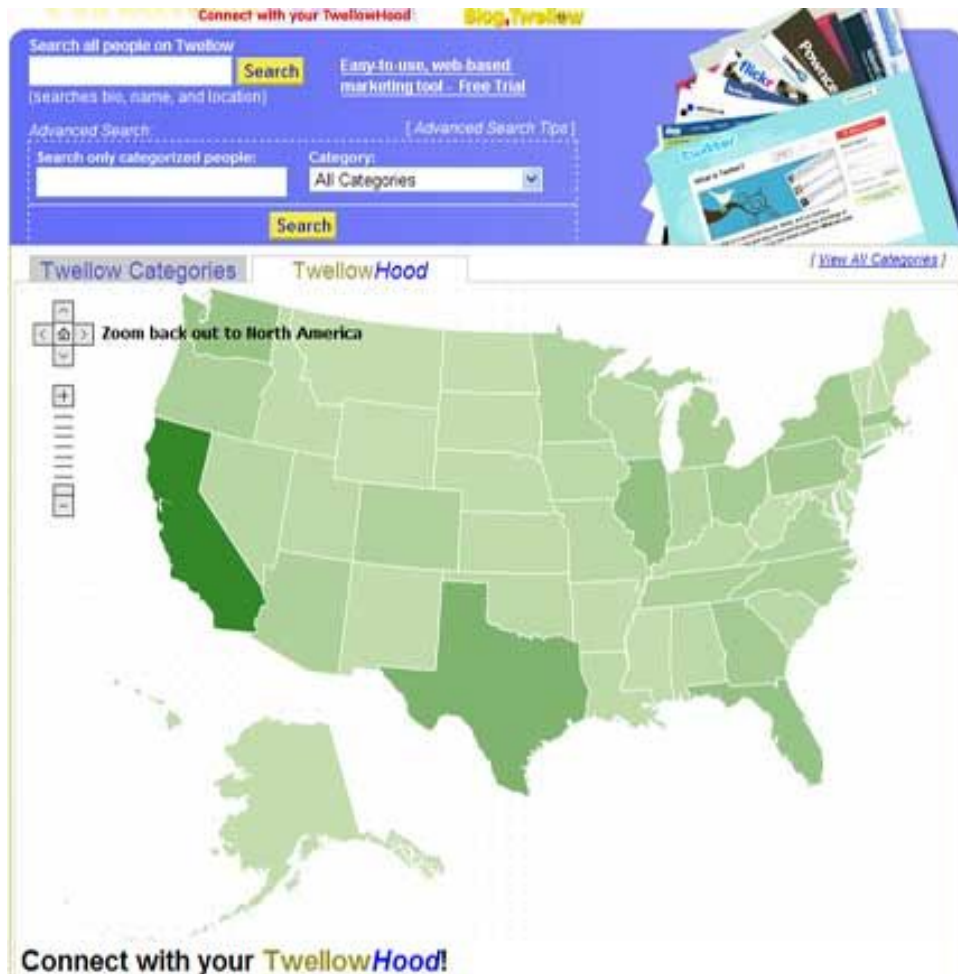
A very useful category is the "Classifieds". A person can list in the "For Hire" or "For Sale" sub categories. This would be useful to advertise your skills or services, or to find someone whose services you needed.

Twellow Neighborhood

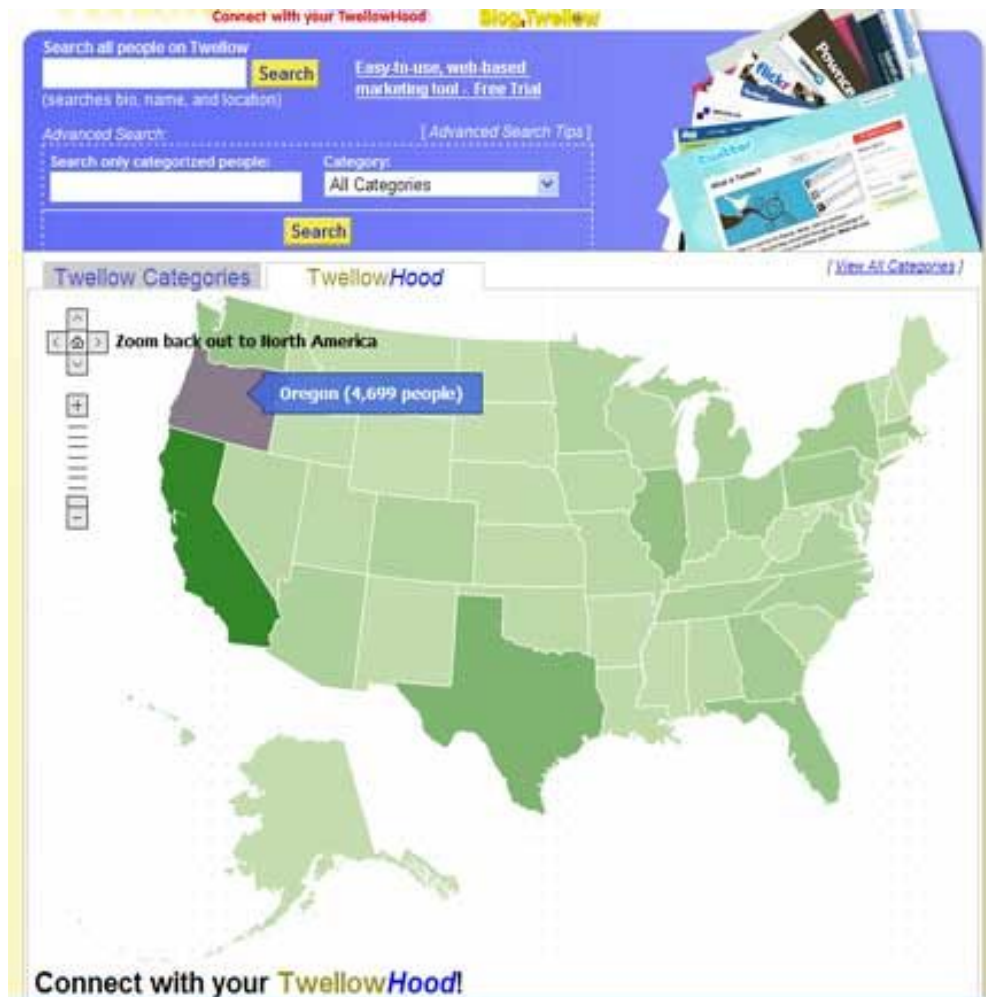
On the home page, right next to the Twellow Categories you will see a grey tab that says "TwellowHood". When you click on that it brings up a page that looks like a map.



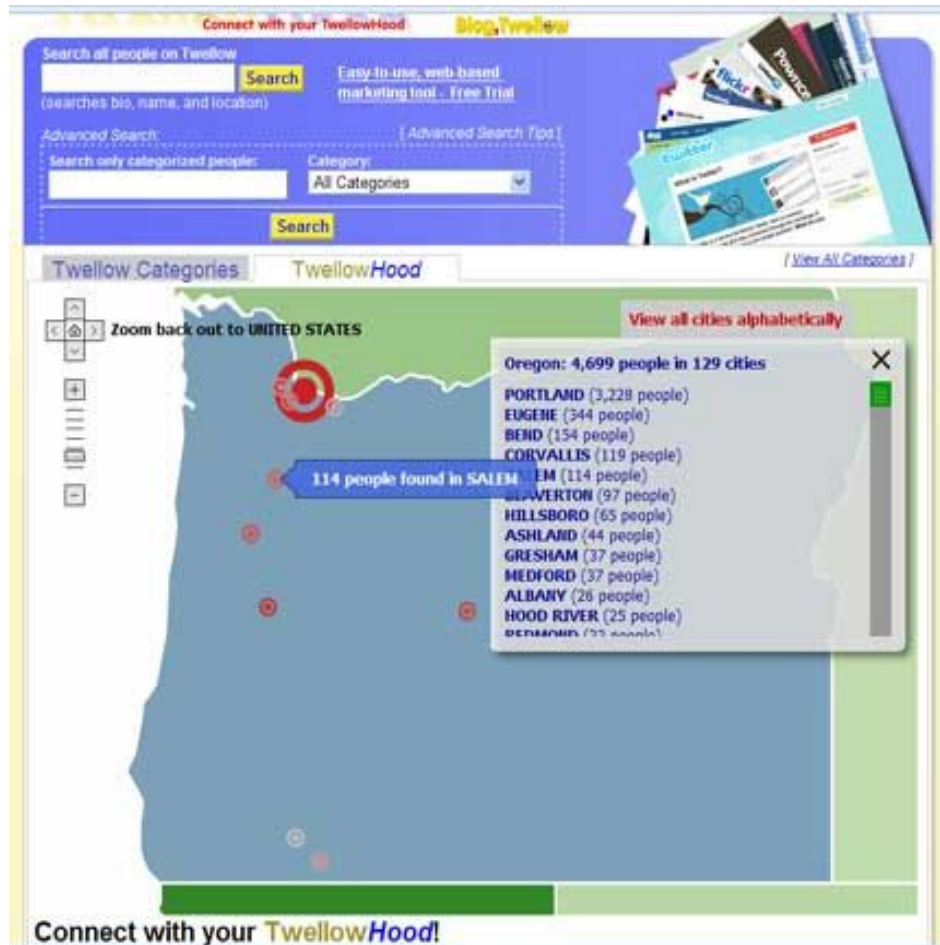
Click on the area that you want to drill down to (for example the main United States area). As you zoom in, it will show the states.



I picked Oregon. Notice how the state will change color and also give you the total for how many people are signed up for Twitter.



Click on the state. TwelloHood will drill down further. Now you will see a detailed map of where the Twitter folks are located. You can mouse over a red circle to get totals for that city.



Now click again on the city, and a new window will open up and you will see the Twitter folks. What a great way to network!

When I checked to see if I was showing up on TwellowHood, I wasn't there. You can add yourself.

For Current Twitter Users

Please note that you must have your twitter account set to NOT protect your updates, as shown in the image below.

Only let people whom I approve follow my updates. If this is checked, you WILL NOT be on the [public timeline](#).

For Non-Twitter Users

In order to become listed on Twellow, you must have a current Twitter account with at least one status update. First [create a twitter account](#), making sure you do not choose the option to have your updates protected, post a status update on the Twitter service, and then fill out and submit the form below.

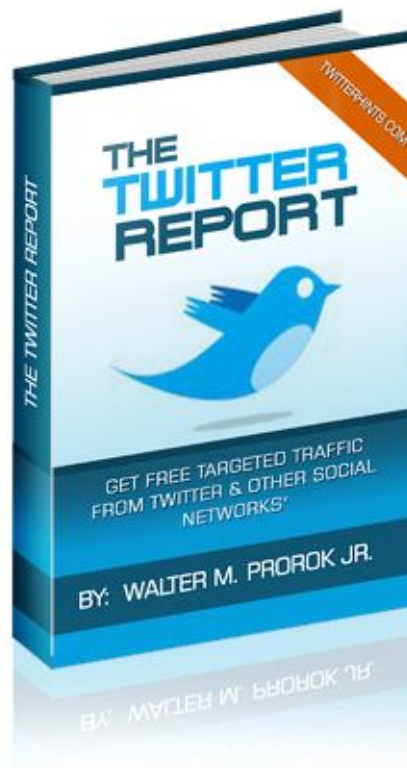
